Show Rules and Guidelines:

1. Show is open to all SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project participants that are registered through the State Meat Goat Project—Ages 5-19 as of Jan. 1, 2017. **Only 4-H and FFA Meat Goat Project participants will be allowed to participate.**
2. Exhibitors will unload their animals and supplies and then move all vehicles and trailers to the designated parking area.
3. **Each exhibitor will be required to pay an entry fee of \$5.00 per class. Make checks payable to Carolina Foothills Heritage Fair.**
4. Exhibitors must furnish feed and water for their animal.
5. Premiums are based upon the Fair or Livestock Shows manager and/or Show committee. All premium amounts will be determined and awarded following the completion of the show.
6. The youth must be able to maintain control their animal(s) at all times during this event. Exhibitors must be able to control their animal(s) at all times during show. Parents are not allowed in the show ring to assist their child during judging. Parents entering the ring during judging to assist their own child will result in the exhibitor being disqualified.
7. Cloverbud exhibitors may request a senior exhibitor to accompany them in the Market Wethers, SC4ME Wethers, or Market Doe classes only. NO assistant will be allowed in Showmanship classes. The assistant is only allowed to step in and control the goat for the safety of the exhibitor(s) or the goat. Assistants are not allowed to lead, set-up or brace the goats.
8. The Carolina Foothills Heritage Fair reserves the right to make decisions concerning or changing rules, regulations, and/or health requirements. Any animal exhibiting any significant visible symptoms of disease or sickness will not be allowed to be unloaded from the vehicle or remain on the fair grounds.
9. ALL DECISIONS BY THE JUDGE ARE FINAL.

Showmanship Classes—(based on the participant's age as of Jan, 1st 2017)

Showmanship is open to SC Meat Goat participants. Exhibitors may show any goat in Showmanship that they have entered in Market Wethers (lottery), SC4ME Wethers (born & bred), or Market Doe classes

- 1-- Cloverbud Division: age 5-8
- 2 --Cloverleaf Division: age 9-11
- 3 --Junior Division: age 12-14
- 4 --Senior Division: age 15-19

Market Classes—Wether Goats only-(3 WEIGHT CLASSES)

Only SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project participants will be allowed to participate in Market Wether Classes with a wether that has a Project Lottery wether ear tag. No "open" wethers are allowed.

Classes 5-7—all Market Meat Goats---classes to be determined day of show

- 8-- Grand Champion Meat Goat
- 9-- Reserve Grand Champion Meat Goat

SC4ME- (Born & Bred Wethers) – (3 WEIGHT CLASSES)

All SC4ME wethers must be tagged with an SC4ME tag and registered to the exhibitor through the SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project

Classes 10-12 Weighed day of show and classes determined

- 13—Grand Champion
- 14—Reserve Grand Champion

Doe Classes—(4 WEIGHT CLASSES)

Market does must be born between September 1, 2016 and June 10, 2017. Market does must be tagged with a SC 4H/FFA Meat Goat Project tag and be registered to the exhibitor. Only one doe per exhibitor per class will be allowed.

Classes 15-18 ---all Doe Class---classes to be determined day of show by weight

- 19--Grand Champion Doe
- 20--Reserve Grand Champion Doe
