4-H RABBIT SHOW INFORMATION

SHOW DATE: SEPTEMBER 30, 2017

LOCATED ON HWY 123, SENECA, SC

Show starts at 10:00 a.m. Registration 9:00 – 9:30 a.m.

The rabbit show is open to all 4-H members throughout South Carolina. Youth ages 5 – 19 are eligible to participate. This show will consist of: **breed class, showmanship, breed ID, judging contest and a written rabbit knowledge exam**. Youth may choose any, or all of the above in which to participate. We will be awarding **the 2017 Rabbit Ambassador** at the conclusion of this year's show. The Ambassador award will be the one person with the highest combined score in showmanship, breed ID OR judging contest and written exam. To be considered for Rabbit Ambassador a youth must participate in showmanship and the written exam. The third component of the award may be chosen from either breed ID, or the judging contest. *Note: if time permits a youth may do both breed ID and judging. However, only one of these events will count towards their total score. Youth must decide before the event which one they would like to include.

We will also be judging **Rabbit Educational Posters** the morning of the show. Please see the Poster Exhibit Guidelines on the Heritage Fair website. Posters will be judged in age divisions: Cloverbud, Cloverleaf, Junior, Senior. A champion and reserve champion will be selected in each division. An overall Grand and overall Reserve Grand Champion will be chosen from the champions of divisions. Every 4-H rabbit member is encouraged to put together an educational poster based on some topic of learning from this year's project.

All rabbit show entries are due to the Oconee Co. Extension Office no later than **SEPTEMBER 20, 2017**. You may enter as many rabbits/breeds in the breed class competition as you desire. You may use a different rabbit for showmanship, or one of the rabbits already entered in breed class.

Members of the Tri-County Furry Friends 4-H Rabbit Club do NOT need to pay show entry fees as their club fees cover their entry. Youth from other counties or from Oconee Co. who are not members of the Tri-County Furry Friends will need to use the following information for paying entry fees:

The first rabbit entered in either breed class OR showmanship is \$5.00. Each additional rabbit is \$1.00 per rabbit. The same rabbit may NOT be shown by more than one exhibitor.

EVERYONE must fill out an entry form and mail it before the deadline!
